What we do

Youth Housing Project (YHP) is a registered charity whose role it is to provide supported accommodation to homeless or at risk of homelessness young people (aged 16- 21 years) on Brisbane's northside.

We house singles, couples, siblings, pregnant and parenting young people/families (partners can be aged up to and include 25 years).

We provide safe and secure housing and responsive, flexible, quality support for young people.

As part of its role in supporting and accommodating young persons, we attempt to provide practical support by way of household goods and food parcels to assist them in establishing a regular way of living.

Queensland statistics

- 25% of all homeless people in Australia are living in Queensland.
- Each night in Brisbane approximately 300 people sleep out on the street
- Nearly 20,000 Queenslanders are homeless
- In Queensland children and young people made up 37% of all homeless people.
- There were more homeless females than homeless males in the 12-18 years age group however this trend reverses in the 19-24 age group (Australian Bureau of Statistics 2006)
- In 2016-17 YHP had 214 enquiries from homeless young people and housed and support 59 young people and 18 accompanying children in their 15 units of accommodation.

What you can do
